HISTORY

The Royal Academy of Cambodia was originally established by Royal Decree on 25 August 1965. Unfortunately, due to the outbreak of war in Cambodia by 1970, its operations were suspended.

On 11 May 1999, RAC was re-established by Royal Decree No. NS/RKT/0599/97 during the second term of the Royal Government of Cambodia. Then, on 26 December 2019, the Royal Academy of Cambodia officially became a public administrative institution.
